## **NESHAMINY FEDERATION OF TEACHERS ELECT OFFICERS**

### ***Members Stick With Current Leaders as Nearly 90 Percent Cast Ballots***

**LANGHORNE, PA (April 26, 2012)** — Neshaminy Federation of Teachers President Louise Boyd will continue in that post after today's vote tallies in the union's leadership election showed her the winner over challenger Chuck Deal.

Boyd teaches biology and Deal teaches business—both at Neshaminy High School.

Results were announced today by the NFT Election Committee, which oversaw the campaign process and voting. The committee counted the votes this afternoon just before an NFT membership meeting convened at Maple Point Middle School.

“The voting went smoothly, with no major problems,” said Jim Knight, a member of the Election Committee. More than 88 percent of the 656 members eligible to vote actually cast ballots.

The results:

- President—Boyd defeated Deal.
- Treasurer—Marian Reed won over Peggy Gale.
- Vice President (five elected)—The winners were Jeff Dunkley, Anne Schmidt, Mary Cwiklinski, Jared Katz and Paul Notwick. They defeated challengers Joe Bodri and Jason Leigh.

The terms for those elected begin July 1 and run for two years.
