**NESHAMINY FEDERATION OF TEACHERS
TO OUTLINE PLANS FOR NEW SCHOOL YEAR**

LANGHORNE, PA (August 9, 2011) — Leaders of the Neshaminy Federation of Teachers are holding a news conference Wednesday morning at the union’s office to present plans for the ongoing effort to reach a contract with the Neshaminy School District.

Teachers in the school system are about to begin their fourth academic year of working without a contract. Talks between the NFT and the Neshaminy School Board have been stalled for several months, despite teachers’ efforts to find savings in health care costs and offering to contribute to health plan premiums.

“In advance of the bargaining session set for this Thursday, Neshaminy teachers want to share with the community what we will be doing in the new school year to continue our efforts to reach an agreement that is good for our students and fair to both teachers and taxpayers,” said Louise Boyd, NFT president.
